2010 Bishop's Appeal

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,


Very soon you will be receiving a request in the mail from Bishop DiLorenzo for the 2010 *Bishop's Appeal*. This is a very important request and I would ask that you read it carefully and spend time praying about this annual appeal. The *Bishop's Appeal* provides important funding for our parishes, our priests, and the future of our Church. Without such an appeal, the Diocese will face a significant deficit in funding our existing programs. The Diocese's goal is \$1,600,000.

What specific programs are being funded? In the area of **Strengthening Our Church** (34%) funds will be directed toward Youth Ministries, Young Adult Ministries, Campus Ministries and Seminarian Education. In the area of **Supporting Our Priests** (25%) funds will be used to assist retired priests, international priests and provide ongoing formation and education of active priests. In the area of **Assisting Our Parishes** (28%), donations will support the Fuel and Hunger Funds for the poor and developing ongoing lay leadership. Additionally, a minimum of 20% of the funds raised will be returned directly to parishes and if parishes exceed their goals, 50% of the funds received will be returned to the parish. Finally, 13% will be used in administration of the program.

There are many unmet and growing needs within the Diocese of Richmond. Without the *Bishop's Appeal*, our Diocese will face a shortfall of \$700,000 in funding our existing programs. On top of this we face growing health care costs for priests in our Diocese. The Diocese also needs to fund more international priests since we have a shortage of domestic priests. Outreach to expand further into more ethnic communities, campus, youth, and young adult ministries is required. The Diocese has committed \$1.3 million for these programs next year. Finally, the Diocese does not want to increase their assessment or cathedraticum to the parishes.

Please watch for the first mailing to be sent to your homes very soon. More information will be coming to you through the mail, the parish bulletin and through communications at mass. Additional details on the Bishop's Appeal can be found shortly on the Richmond Diocese website (www.richmonddiocese.org). Thank you for your continued generosity.

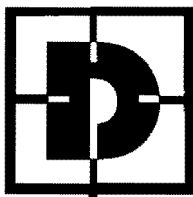
