What is Life Teen?

Life Teen Mission Statement

Life Teen is an international Catholic movement that serves the Church by providing resources and faith experiences that help lead teens closer to Christ. This is accomplished through a vibrant Eucharistic spirituality and by creating opportunities for teens to grow in their faith.

What does a Life Teen program look like?

The Life Teen program is a complete, comprehensive and interactive model of religious formation. Through youth friendly Liturgies, Life Nights, weekly activities, service opportunities, teen leadership and outreach activities, teens learn more about their Catholic faith and grow to love the Sacraments, the Word, and the Mass. At a parish with the Life Teen program, a priest, youth minister, music ministry and a Core team of volunteer's build an environment where teens feel loved, accepted, and challenged to go deeper in their faith.

Teens learn about the **Mass** by being "full, active and conscious" members of the community. Teens not only engage in the liturgy, but also serve as leaders of hospitality, altar servers, lectors, ushers, musicians, vocalists and, when allowed, extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist. "Mother Church earnestly desires that all the faithful should be led to that fully conscious, and active participation in liturgical celebrations which is demanded by the very nature of the liturgy" (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 14). In addition, clergy are renewed and affirmed in their vocation as they reach out to the young Church through the Sacraments.

Youth Ministry News

As the school year approaches, we are looking forward to beginning our new Youth Ministry programs in the Cluster Parishes (Holy Angels, Resurrection, St. Mary's, St. Paul's). This fall, we will kick off the Life Teen program for High School Youth and the Edge program for Middle School Youth. The programs will bring our Cluster youth together at Church of the Resurrection Sunday evenings from 6:00pm-7:30pm, and will be our Christian Formation for students in grades 6-12 from all four parishes. During these sessions, youth will have opportunities for Catechesis, to understand issues relevant to their lives in the context of the teachings of the Church, and to socialize with the other teens from our Cluster. The programs will begin with a Youth Mass at Resurrection on Sunday September 27th at 5:00pm. Youth from the four Cluster Parishes will serve during the Mass, including providing the music. After the Mass, a barbecue will be held for all Cluster youth and their families. Youth and their families will have an opportunity to meet the volunteers who have said yes to God's call to help with Youth Ministry in the Cluster, and to meet other families of teens from the Cluster Parishes. Our first Life Nights and Edge Nights will take place on Sunday October 4th. Pizza will be provided for both High School and Middle School. If you would like to help out with Youth Ministry in the Cluster, there are many ways to be involved. Information about volunteering can be found in your Christian Formation Registration Packet. When you fill out your Christian Formation Registration form, if you indicate that your 10th or 11th grade student needs the Sacrament of Confirmation, a packet of information regarding the Confirmation Preparation process, including a registration form for the program, will be mailed to you. As part of Diocesan guidelines, parents and teens are to attend an orientation meeting prior to beginning Confirmation preparation. 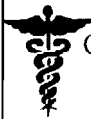

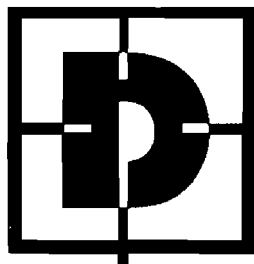
