Cluster News

This week begins the month-long celebration honoring Hispanic Heritage. With its roots in a Congressional declaration dating from 1968, this month highlights the importance of contributions of Hispanics in the United States. In an address to the Hispanic community, Bishop Gerald Barnes of San Bernardino said the Bishops "share your hope of overcoming the discord and prejudices that exist between persons of different races and national origins in the United States. ... We stand together with you in a spirit of celebration, hope and solidarity. We celebrate the many blessings God has given this great nation through the presence of the Hispanic/Latino community...." He invited all members of society to enter into a "respectful dialogue" on immigration, poverty, and other public policy issues confronting the nation. "We want to renew our commitment in solidarity with you, our immigrant brothers and sisters," Bishops Barnes said in conclusion. "We commit ourselves to continue defending your right to attain a dignified and happy life for your family; to reaffirm your presence among us as a blessing; and to recognize your past, present, and future contributions to the life of faith in the prosperity of this nation." As we celebrate this month we recall the stern admonition given by Pope John Paul II during his 1995 visit to the United States: he said our country must not become "less sensitive, less caring toward the poor, the weak, the stranger, the needy."

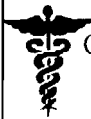

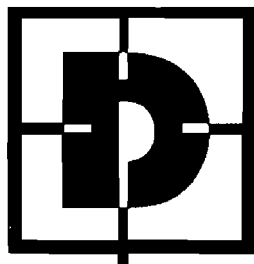
